



FEBRUARY 2010 PUBLIC TRANSIT UPDATE

The **February 2010 Olympic Bus Passes** are available for sale at:

- Tsipun Store [Xit'olacw]
- Lil'Wat Gas [Mt. Currie]
- Pemberton & District Community Centre [Cottonwood St, Pemberton]
- Squamish-Lillooet Regional District office [1350 Aster St, Pemberton]

The passes are **\$50.00 for the month of February** and are valid for:

- *All travel* on the local Pemberton transit route between Mt. Currie/Xit'olacw and Pemberton operating every 30 mins. from 5 am to midnight;
- *All travel* on the Pemberton-Whistler commuter route operating every 12-30 mins. 24 hours per day; and
- *All travel* on Whistler local routes.

Single cash fare trips on the Olympic Bus Network for commuter trips to Whistler are priced at **\$6.00** per ride from Pemberton.

Regular Pemberton-Whistler commuter transit passes & tickets will not be sold for the month of February; commuter tickets will not be honoured from February 1-28, 2010.

Regular "local route only" monthly transit *passes will be sold* and honoured for the month of February, but *no transfers are available* and the adult price is the same as the Olympic Bus Pass. The Olympic passes, which cover both local and commuter trips, would be a more economical option.

Regular "local route only" single fare transit *tickets will be sold* and honoured for the month of February. However, *no transfers are available* so a trip to Whistler would require an *additional \$6.00* fare unless an Olympic Bus Pass is used.

If you have a BC Bus Pass or a CNIB Pass, it will be accepted on the Olympic Bus Network.
