REGIONAL DISTRICT BOARD NAMES CHAIR AND VICE-CHAIR

Directors Rainbow and Ford to continue in roles until December, 2020

Pemberton, BC – The Squamish-Lillooet Regional District (SLRD) Board has elected its Chair and Vice-Chair positions for the coming year.

Electoral Area D Director Tony Rainbow was re-elected by the Board to the position of Chair and Resort Municipality of Whistler Director Jen Ford was re-elected by the Board to the position of Vice-Chair at the Board's November meeting.

"I am honoured to continue to serve the SLRD as Board Chair," said Rainbow. "I would like to thank my fellow directors for their confidence, and for their time and commitment to the Board," he said. "I look forward to continuing to work together to achieve our objectives."

The SLRD is governed by a 10-member board of directors consisting of four electoral area directors and six municipal directors (one director from the District of Lillooet, one director from the Village of Pemberton, two directors from the Resort Municipality of Whistler and two directors from the District of Squamish).

The positions of Chair and Vice-Chair are elected annually by the SLRD Board of Directors.
