The Britannia Beach Volunteer Fire Department (BBVFD) offers an annual Bursary to local students to assist with post-secondary education costs. The 2014 Bursary program is:

DESCRIPTION:

- The Bursary is available to a student from one of the Howe Sound East Communities (Britannia Beach, Furry Creek and Porteau Cove).
- The Bursary is available to a student actively pursuing post-secondary education at a university, college or trade school; and is available to either a Grade 12 graduating student or a student already engaged in post-secondary education programs.
- The Bursary is paid after the student has provided proof of registration at a post-secondary institution.
- The Bursary may be deferred for 1 year (due to course availability, etc.) upon receipt of written request and approval.
- Howe Sound Secondary School (HSS) Grade 12 students must apply according to the criteria outlined in the HSS 2014 Scholarship Book. HSS will forward Grade 12 applications to the Britannia Beach Volunteer Fire Department for selection.
- Bursary applications from Non HSS students should be sent via e-mail directly to the BBVFD c/o the e-mail address listed below. Applications should include all contact information and a one page letter that highlights the applicant's academic achievements, career goals, volunteerism and any other applicable information.
