

TRAFFIC IMPACT GUIDE



The 32nd Annual Subaru IRONMAN Canada Event will take place in Whistler, the Callaghan Valley and the Pemberton Valley on Sunday, July 27th, 2014. To ensure safety for everyone — athletes, volunteers, spectators and travelers — IRONMAN Canada will require traffic pattern changes throughout the day and drivers may risk experiencing some significant delays due to various highway closures.

Whistler Traffic Chart:

This chart outlines the traffic pattern changes on Hwy 99 and throughout the Whistler area during the event week.

Traveling south- to Whistler:

- Vehicles from Pemberton traveling southbound on Hwy 99 should arrive at their destination in Whistler by 7:00am.
- Between 7:00am and 10:30am, vehicles will still be able to travel southbound on Hwy 99, although Whistler access will be limited to Alpine Way.

Traveling south- from Whistler:

- Vehicles will be able to leave Whistler, traveling to Squamish and further south, either before 7:00am or after 12:30pm.
- All vehicles should pass Callaghan Valley Road before 8:00am.

Traveling north- from Whistler:

- Vehicles traveling to Pemberton and further north should pass Alpine Way before 8:45am or after 1:30pm.

Traveling north- to Whistler:

- Vehicles will be able to travel north to Whistler throughout the event.
- Between 8:30am and 12:30pm there will be no left turns allowed off Hwy 99 and delays should be expected from the Callaghan Valley Road to Alpine Way. During this time, access to Whistler Village is via Whistler Way, Village Gate, Lorimer Road or Nancy Green Drive.

Valley Trail Usage:

- The Valley Trail will be open however the run course will use some sections of the Valley Trail. Pedestrians and bicycles use caution while on the Valley Trail.

Traveling north- from Whistler:

- Vehicles will be able to leave Whistler, traveling to Pemberton and further north (e.g. Pemberton Airport Road, Mt. Currie, Duffey Lake Road, etc.) either before 8:45am or after 1:30pm.
- Vehicles will be able to access all locations in Pemberton after 4:30pm.

Traveling south- to Whistler:

- Vehicles from Pemberton traveling southbound on Hwy 99 should arrive at their destination in Whistler by 7:00am.
- After 4:30pm vehicles will be able to travel southbound to Whistler on Hwy 99 from Portage Road under controlled traffic management. Expect some slow moving southbound traffic on Hwy 99 while the bike course is cleared. Please note, further closures and turning restrictions may be encountered once in Whistler.

Pedestrian and bicycle traffic:

- Pedestrians and bicycles will be able to travel in and out of downtown Pemberton and may cross Portage Road with assistance from traffic control personnel.

Access to Pemberton Health Centre:

- Access to the Pemberton Health Centre will be maintained all day via a one-way loop lane (Portage Road, Aspen Blvd, Oak Street, Urdal Road, Hemlock St, Harrow Road and Hwy 99).
- Access will also be available from Pemberton Farm Road and Collins Road via temporary opening of Urdal Road and Hemlock Road gate, with a detour through The Glen.
