Mount Meager Landslide Hazard Notification

The Regional District will regularly publish a notice in the local newspapers, on the SLRD website, and on the public notice posting place designated in the Board's procedure bylaw, disclosing the "Hazard and risk from large landslides from Mount Meager volcano, British Columbia, Canada" as published in the journal *Georisk: Assessment and Management of Risk for Engineered Systems and Geohazards*.

The Regional District will publish an annual notice, in the form as attached to this policy, in the Whistler (and Pemberton) newspaper(s), the SLRD website, and on the public notice posting place designated in the Board's procedure bylaw, as amended from time to time.

NOTICE OF HAZARD

The Squamish-Lillooet Regional District has received a copy of an article entitled

"Hazard and risk from large landslides from Mount Meager volcano, British Columbia, Canada"

that has been published in the journal *Georisk: Assessment and Management of Risk for Engineered Systems and Geohazards*. The article identifies a safety risk to persons and property from debris flows in the Mount Meager and Lillooet River valley areas as far south as the head of Lillooet Lake.

A copy of the article has been placed in the Pemberton Public Library and the article is accessible on the Regional District's website at www.slrd.bc.ca.
