



## Community Update: Seton Fire Protection Service

Effective December 19, 2024, the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District (SLRD) and Tsal'alh have finalized a long-term agreement for Tsal'alh to provide fire protection services in the Seton/Shalalth fire service area.

In conjunction with the fire protection services agreement, Tsal'alh has also taken occupancy of the SLRD-owned Seton Firehall, located at 7373 Seton Portage Road, pursuant to a new lease. The SLRD is very pleased that Tsal'alh has joined BC Ambulance Services as joint tenants of the Seton Firehall, providing essential services to local communities.

The SLRD and Tsal'alh have worked collaboratively for many years to achieve these agreements. The SLRD is grateful to have reached these significant milestones, ensuring the long-term, year-round sustainability of fire protection services in the service area. These agreements will also preserve the most favourable Fire Underwriters' Survey (FUS) grading, helping maintain the lowest possible fire insurance rates for homeowners. Tsal'alh will be relocating some of their equipment, apparatus, and personnel to the Seton Firehall to facilitate prompt and responsive structure firefighting capability to the service area.

The SLRD wishes to express its gratitude to the community for their patience and support throughout this process. We also extend our sincere appreciation to BC Ambulance Service, Tsal'alh, and all of the volunteers who are committed to keeping the community safe.
