

EVACUATION ALERT EXPANDED – SLRD ELECTORAL AREA A Bonanza Creek Wildfire K71082

Updated: Aug 6, 2026, at 1600 hrs

Based on recommendations from the BC Wildfire Service, the **Evacuation Alert** issued by the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District on July 22, 2026, at 1330 hrs, updated on July 22, 2026 at 2000 hrs, in Electoral Area A due to the Bonanza Creek (K71082) and the French Bar Creek K70748 wildfires has been **expanded** to include additional areas to the north and east.

Because of the potential danger to life and health, the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District has maintained and issued an expanded **Evacuation Alert** for the following properties:

- Areas West of Jones Creek and North of Carpenter Lake, including Marshall Lake and Tyaughton Lake
- Areas of Gold Bridge North of the Bridge River, including Gun Lake and Gun Creek Road
- Areas North of Downton Lake
- Areas to the North and East of Marshall Lake Rd
- **All SLRD properties as outlined in the attached map.**

NOTE: Some areas north of Evacuation ALERT are on Evacuation ORDER effective July 22, 2026 at 2000hrs. To view that Evacuation ORDER, visit www.slrd.bc.ca/eoc.

An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible before evacuation; however, you may receive limited notice due to rapidly changing conditions.

NOW IS THE TIME TO PREPARE FOR AN EVACUATION

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Pre-register for Emergency Support Services online at: <https://ess.gov.bc.ca/>
- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside of the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g., insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Prepare to move people who may need additional time to evacuate, children and/or neighbours who would require assistance.

- If you require assistance, call the **24/7 SLRD Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) on-call Duty Manager** at **604-384-7357**.
- Impacted or concerned agricultural producers are asked to please contact the **SLRD Agricultural Coordinator** directly at **604-384-7329**.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- Arrange transportation and accommodations for all your household members, if possible, and fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles.
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating.
