

EVACUATION ORDER UPDATED SLRD ELECTORAL AREA B PEAR LAKE WILDFIRE C40983

Issued: August 29, 2026 at 1700 hrs

Pursuant to Section 95 (1) of the BC Emergency and Disaster Management Act, an EVACUATION ORDER issued by the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District due to immediate danger to public safety caused by the Pear Lake Wildfire has been **updated** in an abundance of caution, to maintain a safe border around the southern perimeter of the Pear Lake Wildfire and to exclude parcels downgraded from Evacuation Order to Alert, effective August 29, 2026 at 1700 hrs.

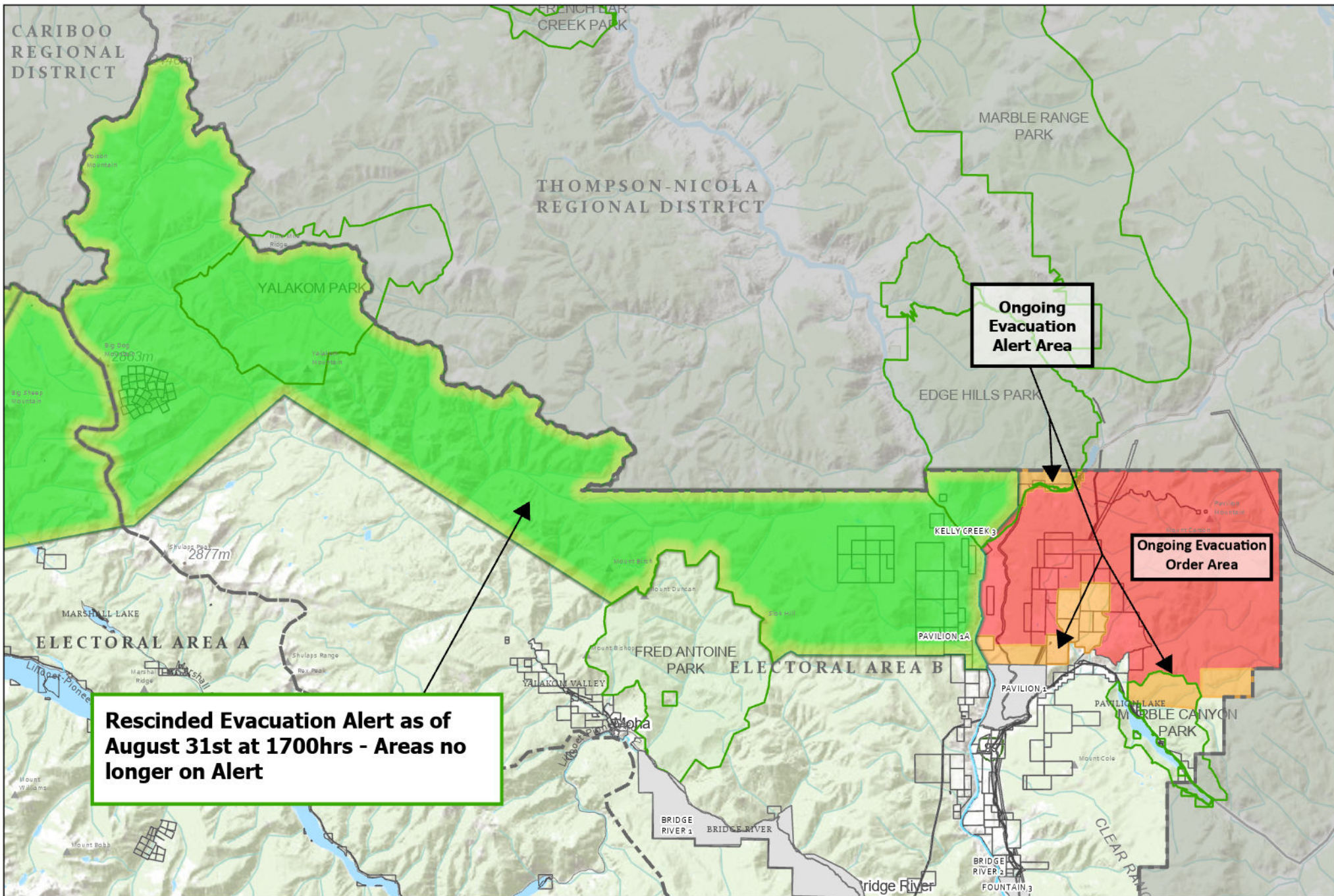
