- There will be a member of the fire department on site during our filming days.
- There will be use of an unmanned air vehicle (drone).
- There will be security watching our gear and sets for the duration while we are on the property.

### Tuesday November 25 and Monday, December 1; Tuesday, December 2; and Wednesday, December 3

**5:00pm to 6:00am (daily)**

- All filming will take place on private property at Minaty Bay.
- There will be special effects fire, atmospheric smoke and stunts during our filming days. **There will be simulated pyrotechnics each night.**
- There will be a member of the fire department on site during our filming days.
- There will be use of an unmanned air vehicle (drone).
- There will be security watching our gear and sets for the duration while we are on the property.

**7:00am to 7:00pm (daily)**

- A reduced crew will be at the location for post-film clean up.
