Thursday, October 30th, 2025

5:30pm to 2:30am (Friday Morning)

- All filming will take place on private property at Minaty Bay.
- There will be special effects fire, atmospheric smoke and stunts during our filming days.
- There will be a member of the fire department on site during our filming days.
- We will not be impeding the highway in anyway with lights or special effects smoke.
- There will be use of an unmanned air vehicle (drone).
- There will be security watching our gear and sets for the duration while we are on the property.

Friday, October 31st, 2025

7:00am to 7:00pm

- A reduced crew will be at working Minaty Bay to prepare for filming.
- There will be security daily and overnight to watch our gear. There will be no work over the weekend.

Monday, November 3rd, 2025

7:30am to 6:00pm

- All filming will take place on private property at Minaty Bay.
- All our scenes are daylight dependant.
- There will be special effects fire, atmospheric smoke and stunts during our filming days.
- There will be a member of the fire department on site during our filming days.
- We will not be impeding the highway in anyway with lights or special effects smoke.
- There will be use of an unmanned air vehicle (drone).
- There will be security watching our gear and sets for the duration while we are on the property.

Tuesday, November 4th, 2025 to Friday, November 7th, 2025

7:00am to 7:00pm (daily)

- A reduced crew will be at the location for post-film clean up.
