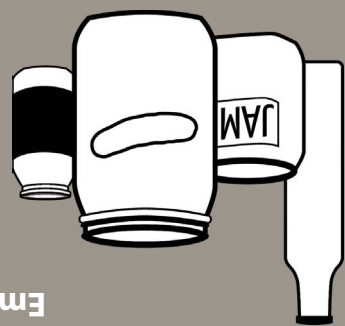

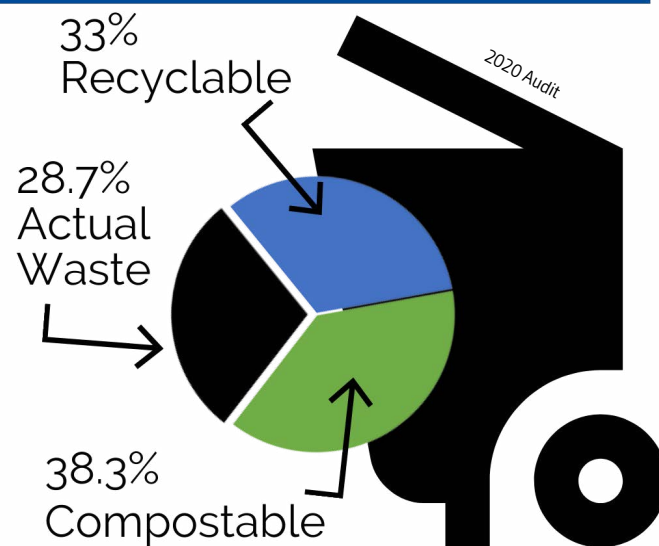

Wildlife

Access to waste (garbage, recycling and organics) is a leading cause of wildlife conflicts. Keep wildlife wild and your community safe:

- ✓ Store waste indoors or in bear-resistant containers. Truck canopies are not bear-resistant.
- ✓ Ensure recyclables are clean & stored indoors.
- ✓ Freeze smelly items in newspaper & rinse organic collection bins.

Leaving attractants accessible to wildlife is against SLRD bylaws & the BC Wildlife Act.

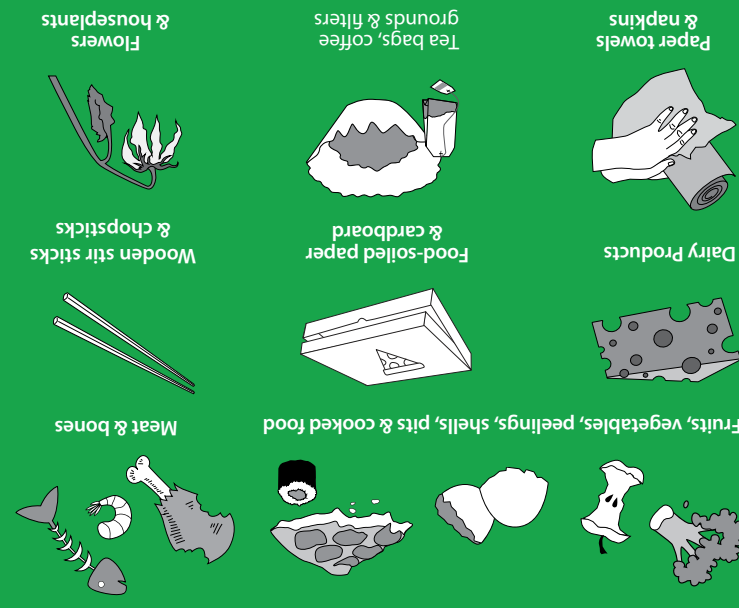

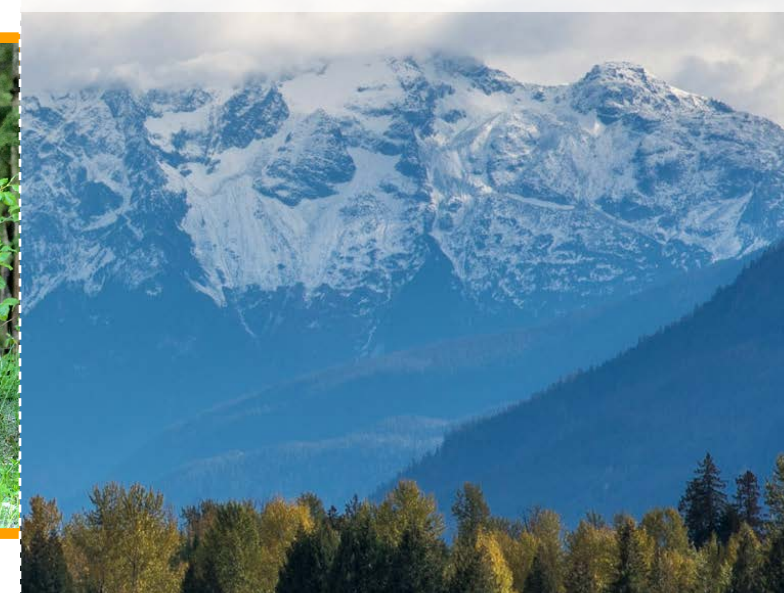

INVASIVE SPECIES

Garbage to Landfill



Small bag (< 40 L or 9 kg)
Large bag (> 40 L or 9 kg)
Per tonne for larger loads

Reduce costs by reducing waste.

Commercial loads or loads greater than a pick-up truck and 12" trailer: Take to Callaghan Waste Transfer Station

Not accepted in garbage:

- Hazardous, flammable or biomedical waste
- Animal carcasses
- Automobile hulks and engines
- Recyclables or organics; sort accordingly

TIPPING FEES & SERVICES

Waste management fees are collected by taxes & tipping fees. Tipping fees ensure that those who generate the waste help to cover the disposal cost.

Household Hazardous Waste

Accepted:



Pesticides
Liquid, solid and aerosol pesticides.
Maximum container size is 10 litres.
Maximum aerosol container size is 680g/24oz.



- ✓ Poison symbol (skull and crossbones)
- ✓ Pest Control Product (PCP) number
- ✓ Word 'domestic' on the label



Flammable liquids
Liquid and aerosol flammables. Must display the flammable symbol. Gasoline will only be accepted in ULC-approved gas can or jerry can.

- ✓ Gasoline, including stale or old gasoline contaminated with oil or water
- ✓ Acetone
- ✓ BBQ lighter fluid
- ✓ Camping fuel (liquid only)
- ✓ Flammable degreasers
- ✓ Flammable liquid adhesives
- ✓ Flammable lubricants
- ✓ Fondue fuel
- ✓ Furniture stripper
- ✓ Kerosene
- ✓ Paint stripper

Flexible Plastics

Accepted: Empty & Rinsed



Not accepted:

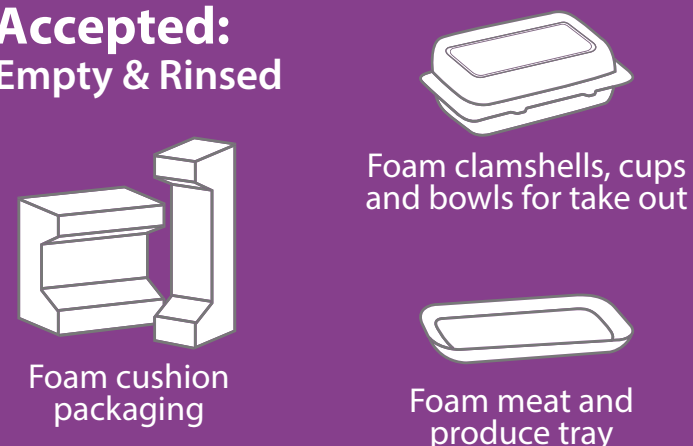
- Plastic-lined paper or paper-lined plastic ●
- Biodegradable or compostable plastic ●
- Plastic squeeze tubes (e.g. tooth paste) ●
- Plastic strapping ●
- PVC or Vinyl ●



Foam Packaging

Separate White & Coloured

Accepted: Empty & Rinsed



Not accepted:

- Foam packing chips, peanuts or noodles ●
- Liquid absorbing pads or stretch wrap ●
- Blue or pink foam board insulation ●



Refundables

Deposit Beverage Containers

Accepted:

Empty & rinsed, labels ok



- Aluminum cans
- Glass bottles
- Plastic bottles & jugs
- Gable tops, juice boxes & tetra packs
- Bag-in-a-box
