3. Memberships & Welcome to new members

4. SLRD Update and Progress

The regional district had a disposal rate of 359 kg/person in 2022, compared to 440 kg/person in 2021. The disposal rate per person is higher in the North due to the rural and remote nature of the communities.

347 kg/person by 2026 is the goal per the Solid Waste and Resource Management Plan.

SLRD shared SWRMP actions and initiative updates since the last meeting.

5. DOS Demolition Waste Diversion Bylaw

L. Wittenzellner presented the District of Squamish Demolition Waste Diversion Bylaw, including waste composition data, development process, desired outcomes, Bylaw overview and case studies.

6. BC Single-Use Plastic Waste Prevention Regulation

The province updated the BC Single-Use Plastic Waste Prevention Regulation page to include easy-to-understand and comprehensive guidance documents and downloadable content for businesses to use.

SLRD will send an email with the URL and key dates to be shared by municipalities with their chambers of commerce and businesses. Some municipalities have already shared the regulation information and content with their chambers of commerce.

7. RMOW Dog Waste Pilot

RMOW presented an overview of the dog waste collection program in the off-leash parks that has been successful for a number of years. The main barrier the initiative faces when considering expansion into other areas is contamination.
