BEFORE

Register for

Take photos and videos of farm
assets in good (before) condition

Secure pets and
valuables

Prepare horses and
livestock to shelter in
place or to be relocated

DURING

Prioritize your safety and follow
evacuation directions

Evacuate horses and
livestock if necessary

Return horses and livestock
when evacuation order is
lifted, if safe to do so

AFTER

Take photos and/or videos to
document impacts and begin to file
insurance claims if possible
