- Election Officials are responsible for:
  - setting up and tearing down the voting location (tables, voting booths, signs, and notices);
  - greeting electors;
  - dealing tactfully and courteously with the public;
  - registering electors to vote and verifying elector identification using a paper list;
  - providing ballots to eligible electors;
  - directing electors to the table where they can vote;
  - overseeing the placement of ballots in ballot boxes;
  - assisting electors as required; and
  - securing ballot boxes at the end of the day. On General Voting Day (October 17), Election Officials are also responsible for counting ballots at the end of the night.
- Election Officials living within commuting distance from their assigned voting location are expected to arrange, at their own cost, transportation to and from the voting location.
- For successful applicants, please note that shifts will be confirmed on or around September 21, 2026 (the date when election by voting, or acclamations in any of the electoral areas and/or school districts will be declared).
- Earnings are subject to income tax and statutory deductions, and the SLRD will issue a T4 slip by mail in February 2027.
