

# SLRD Downton Lake Wildfire Waste Disposal

The SLRD recommends anyone dealing with burnt debris to hire a qualified professional to conduct a hazard assessment and test for asbestos as well as hire a qualified professional for safe disposal.



## Insurance

Always check with your insurance provider first regarding disposal of solid waste related to wildfires. Insurance may cover costs of removal and disposal.

## Burnt Debris, Asbestos or Suspected Asbestos-Contaminated Materials

Burnt buildings and residual ash may contain hazardous materials such as asbestos and toxic chemicals and are subject to special disposal regulations to protect health and safety of workers and publics. Materials disposal requires laboratory testing and analysis prior to acceptance at disposal facilities as per the Ministry of Environment. Please submit the results of the testing and the [Asbestos Disposal Form](#) to [utilities@slrd.bc.ca](mailto:utilities@slrd.bc.ca). For more information, contact the SLRD at 604-894-6371 ext. 292.

With approval, contaminated materials can be disposed of by appointment only. You must contact the SLRD and provide lab results and an [Asbestos Disposal Form](#) at least 10 days prior to disposal. Contaminated materials must be double-bagged and sealed. For asbestos management and disposal requirements, visit the [Asbestos Management Page](#). Waste must be equal or less than the ambient outdoor temperature.

\*If you are able to provide proof (ie: a building permit) of your structure being built after 1990, you will not need to undergo the asbestos testing process.



## Non-Burnt Debris

Damaged materials due to smoke, water, etc. excluding burned materials can be brought to a permitted SLRD disposal facility. \*Regular regulations apply.



## Tip Fees

Tip fees have been waived at Gold Bridge Transfer Station for fridges, freezers, & household waste. All other waste is subject to regular tip fees.

**Asbestos Waste @ only Gold Bridge Transfer Station:** \$70.00/m2. Min. charge: \$10.00.

**Payments accepted:** Gold Bridge Transfer Station: cash, account.  
Lillooet Landfill: cash, debit, credit, account.
