

EVACUATION ALERT - SLRD AREA C TWIN TWO CREEK WILDFIRE V30941

UPDATED: July 23, 2026, at 2130 hrs

Based on recommendations from the BC Wildfire Service, an **Evacuation Alert** has been issued by the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District due to the Twin Two Creek (V30941) burning out of control east of Lillooet Lake.

Because of the potential danger to life and health, the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District has issued an **Evacuation Alert** for the following properties:

- Lillooet Lake Estates
- Heather Jean Properties
- Lizzie Bay Recreation Site
- Strawberry Point Recreation Site
- Driftwood Bay Recreation Site
- 6206 In-Shuck Ch FSR
- 6400 In-Shuck Ch FSR
- 6624 In-Shuck Ch FSR
- **All SLRD properties as outlined in the attached map.**

NOTE: Some areas in the centre of this Evacuation ALERT area have now been placed on Evacuation ORDER effective July 23, 2026 at 2130hrs. To view that Evacuation ORDER, visit www.slrd.bc.ca/eoc.

An **Evacuation Alert** has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible before evacuation; however, you may receive limited notice due to rapidly changing conditions.

NOW IS THE TIME TO PREPARE FOR AN EVACUATION

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Pre-register for Emergency Support Services online at: <https://ess.gov.bc.ca/>.
- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside of the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g., insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Prepare to move people who may need additional time to evacuate, children and/or neighbours who would require assistance.
- If you require assistance, call the SLRD Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) at 604-384-7357.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).

- Arrange transportation and accommodations for all your household members, if possible, and fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles.
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating.
