

## SQUAMISH-LILLOOET REGIONAL DISTRICT

### BYLAW NO. 1242-2012

A Bylaw to Amend the Pemberton/Electoral Area C Recreation Advisory Committee Establishment and Delegation of Authority Bylaw,  
Squamish-Lillooet Regional District Bylaw No.1111-2008

---

**WHEREAS** the Pemberton/Electoral Area C Recreation Advisory Committee Establishment and Delegation of Authority Bylaw, Squamish-Lillooet Regional District Bylaw No.1111-2008 provided for the establishment of the Pemberton / Electoral Area C Recreation Advisory Committee (“RAC”) for the express purpose of providing comments and recommendations to the Pemberton Valley Utilities and Services Committee (“PVUS”) on recreation issues within the Village of Pemberton, Electoral Area C and Mt. Currie referred to RAC by PVUS;

**AND WHEREAS** the express role of RAC shall be to provide advice and recommendations to PVUS on the following areas:

- a. Recreation activities and programs for the community;
- b. Education of the public regarding leisure, philosophy or recreation policies established for the community;
- c. Promotion and encouragement of leadership training, workshops, clinics in sports, arts and crafts, music, drama, leadership techniques and qualities, administration, conferences and related fields;
- d. Special events, community days, and festivals;
- e. Planning of active parks, passive parks, playgrounds and open spaces which include trails;

**AND WHEREAS** the foregoing, of necessity, involves the Pemberton and Electoral Area C schools, their staff, their school grounds and playing fields, and the School District No. 48 Board and Administration.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Board of the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. Sections 4 and 6 of Bylaw 1111 is hereby amended by deleting the following words:

“Village of Pemberton, Electoral Area C and Mt. Currie”;

and replacing them with the following words:

“Village of Pemberton and Electoral Area C”.

2. Section 8 of Bylaw No. 1111 is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefore as Section 8:

#### Membership

8. The Committee shall consist of:
  - (a). a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 9 members appointed by the Commission. Committee members shall be selected from:
    - (i) recreation user groups; and
    - (ii) the public at large.
  - (b). a School Trustee from Pemberton or Area C appointed, along with the unappointed Trustee as the Alternate, by School District No.48 on an annual basis, who shall sit as a non-voting member of the Committee.
