

SQUAMISH-LILLOOET REGIONAL DISTRICT

BY-LAW NO. 936-2005

A by-law to amend Squamish-Lillooet Regional District Refuse Disposal Site Tipping Fee By-law No. 525, 1993 (Schedule E - Gold Bridge Transfer Station)

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Act, the Regional Board may, by by-law, establish, maintain and operate grounds for disposal of garbage and waste;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board established and imposed charges for the use of the disposal site;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board deems it advisable to revise the Schedule of Tipping Fees imposed for the use of the disposal site;

NOW THEREFORE, the Regional Board of the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This by-law may be cited as the "Squamish-Lillooet Regional District Refuse Disposal Site Tipping Fee Amendment By-law No. 936, 2004". (Schedule E - Gold Bridge Transfer Station)
2. Squamish-Lillooet Regional District Refuse Disposal Site Tipping Fee By-law No. 525, 1995 is hereby amended as follows:
 - i Squamish-Lillooet Regional District Refuse Disposal Site Tipping Fee Amendment By-law No. 696, 1999". (Schedule E – Gold Bridge Transfer Station) is hereby repealed and replaced with a new Schedule "E" attached hereto.

READ A THIRD TIME this 28th day of February, 2005.

SCHEDULE E

Gold Bridge Transfer Station

- A. Residential households within Electoral Area A are permitted to dispose of a maximum of two bags (maximum size 77 litres, 18 Gallons, or less) of solid waste in a single week (Sunday through Saturday) without tipping fees being applied. All other incoming municipal solid waste shall be charged according to the rates listed below.
- B. A minimum charge of \$100.00 or 10 times the appropriate tipping fee, whichever is greater, will be applied to any refuse left without the permission of the attendant, any waste left outside the gate, when the landfill is closed, or that is illegally dumped.
- C. The Gold Bridge Transfer Station attendant has the right to refuse any or all materials entering the Gold Bridge facility.
