

# SQUAMISH-LILLOOET REGIONAL DISTRICT

## BYLAW NO. 1083-2008

A bylaw to establish The Heights Fire Protection Service

---

### WHEREAS:

- A. Under section 796 of the *Local Government Act* a Regional District may operate any service the Board considers necessary or desirable for all or part of the Regional District;
- B. The Board of the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District wishes to establish a service for the purpose of operating a fire protection;
- C. The approval of the Inspector of Municipalities has been obtained under section 801 of the *Local Government Act*; and
- D. The approval of the electors in the participating area has been obtained under section 801.2 (Approval by Assent of the Electors) of the *Local Government Act*.

NOW THEREFORE the Board of the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

### **Service**

- 1. The service established by this Bylaw is The Heights Fire Protection Service (the "Service") for the purpose of operating a fire protection service within the service area established by this bylaw.

### **Boundaries**

- 2. The boundaries of the Service Area are a portion of Electoral Area C, being the communities of Walkerville, Reid Road, Owl Ridge and environs as shown outlined on the map attached as Schedule "A" (the "Service Area").

### **Participating Area**

- 3. The "Participating Area" is a portion of Electoral Area C, being the communities of Walkerville, Reid Road, Owl Ridge and environs as shown outlined on the map attached to this bylaw as Schedule "A".

### **Cost Recovery**

4. As provided in section 803 of the *Local Government Act*, the annual cost of providing the Service shall be recovered by one or more of the following:
  - (a) property value taxes imposed in accordance with Division 4.3 of Part 24 of the *Local Government Act*; and
  - (b) parcel taxes imposed in accordance with Division 4.3 of Part 24 of the *Local Government Act*;
  - (c) fees and charges imposed under section 797.2 of the *Local Government Act*;
  - (d) revenues raised by other means authorized by the *Local Government Act* or another Act;
  - (e) revenues received by way of agreement, enterprises, gift, grant or otherwise.

**Maximum Requisition**

5. In accordance with section 800.1(1)(e) of the *Local Government Act*, the maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually for the cost of the Service is \$0.633/\$1,000 of the net taxable value of land and improvements.

**Schedule**

6. The schedule to this bylaw is an integral part of this bylaw.

**Effective Dates**

7. This Bylaw takes effect upon from the date of its adoption.

**Citation**

8. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "The Heights Fire Protection Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1083-2008".
