



**Elector Response Form –  
Alternative Approval Process**

Establishing Bylaw No. 1644-2019

The Squamish-Lillooet Regional District (“SLRD”) is considering the following bylaws (collectively, the “Bylaws”):

- Squamish-Lillooet Regional District (“ Pemberton and District Arts, Culture and Recreation Service Establishing Bylaw No. 1643-2019 authorizes the SLRD to requisition funds for local arts, culture, and recreation purposes (“Bylaw No. 1643”); and
- Squamish-Lillooet Regional District (“ Pemberton and District Economic Development Service Establishing Bylaw No. 1644-2019 authorizes the SLRD to requisition funds for economic development purposes (“Bylaw No. 1644”).

The Bylaws allow for service delivery contracts with external parties. The Bylaws apply to the Village of Pemberton and all of Electoral Area C except the WedgeWoods neighbourhood as participants (the “Participants”), as shown on the map below attached as Schedule “A” (the “Service Area”).

The maximum annual requisition amount of each of the Bylaws is to be allocated between the Participants on the basis of the total assessment base of the Participants. If implemented as planned, the tax requisitions are estimated as follows:

**For Property Owners within the Village of Pemberton**

- For Bylaw No. 1643, the maximum annual requisition amount is estimated to be the greater of \$75,000 or \$0.0475/\$1,000 applied to the net taxable value of land and improvements. This is \$4.75 per \$100,000 of value.

- For Bylaw No. 1644, the maximum annual requisition amount is estimated to be the greater of \$50,000 or \$0.0317/\$1,000 applied to the net taxable value of land and improvements. This is \$3.17 per \$100,000 of value.

**For Property Owners within all of Electoral Area C except the WedgeWoods neighbourhood**

(The following rates are subject to a mandatory 5.25% provincial fee which is added to properties within electoral areas.)

- Under Bylaw No. 1643, the maximum annual requisition amount is estimated to be the greater of \$75,000 or \$0.05/\$1,000 applied to the net taxable value of land and improvements. This is \$5.00 per \$100,000 of value.

- Under Bylaw No. 1644, the maximum annual requisition amount is estimated to be the greater of \$50,000 or \$0.0334/\$1,000 applied to the net taxable value of land and improvements. This is \$3.34 per \$100,000 of value.

The SLRD Board may proceed with the adoption of the Bylaws unless 475 electors sign and submit a completed copy of this elector response form to the SLRD by the deadline of 4:30 p.m. on November 12, 2019.

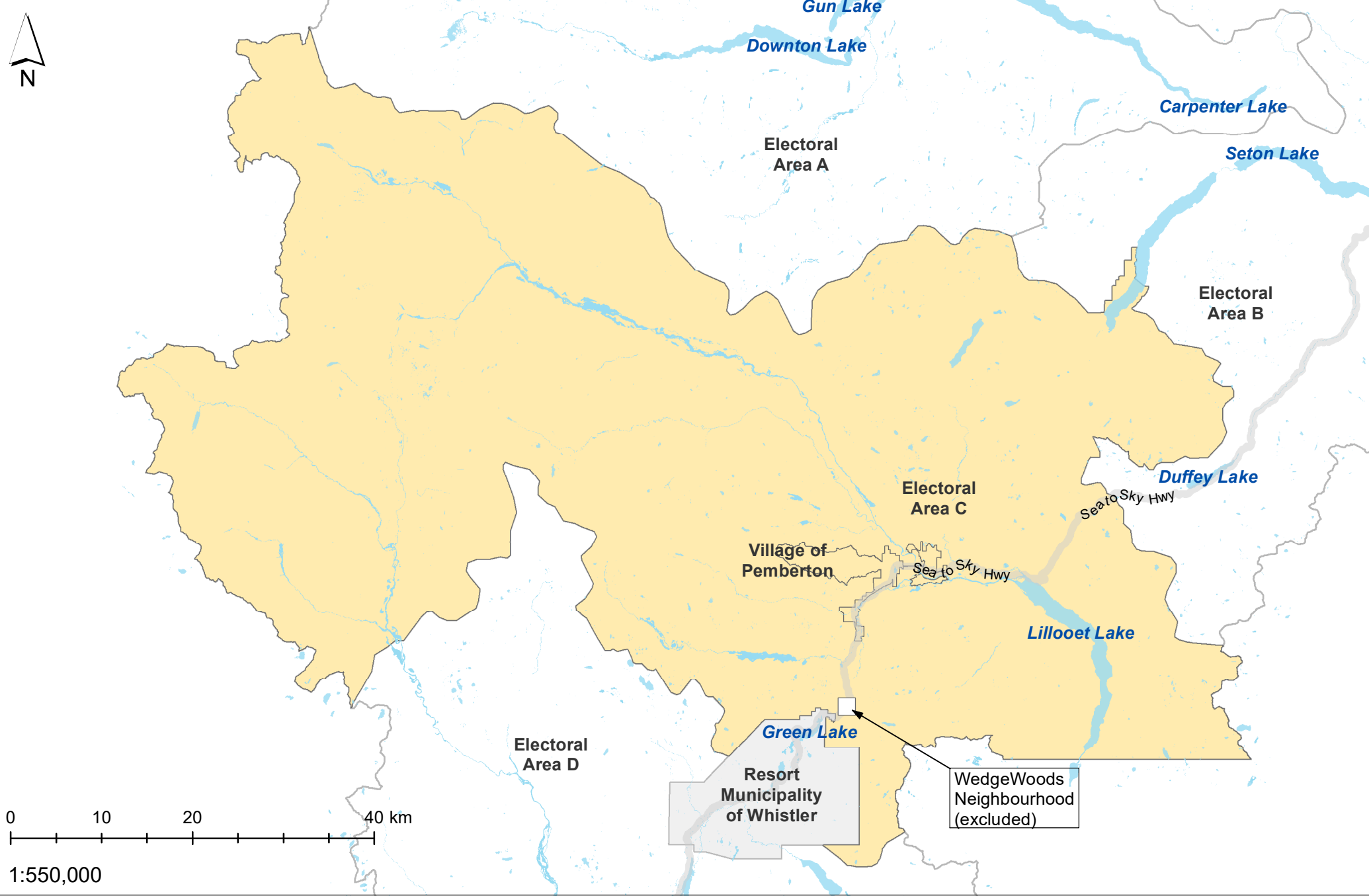
## Eligibility Requirements

### Resident Electors (section 65 of the *Local Government Act*):


1. I am 18 years of age or older;
2. I am a Canadian citizen;
3. I have lived in British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before signing this elector response form;
4. I have lived in the Service Area (see definition in Notice of Alternative Approval Process form) for at least 30 days before signing this elector response form;
5. I am not disqualified from voting under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment or otherwise disqualified by law from voting.

### Non-Resident Property Electors (section 66 of the *Local Government Act*):

1. I am 18 years of age or older;
2. I am a Canadian citizen;
3. I have lived in British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before signing this elector response form;
4. I am not entitled to vote as a resident elector in the Service Area (see definition in Notice of Alternative Approval Process form) for purposes of this matter;
5. I have been a registered owner of real property in the Service Area for at least 30 days before signing this elector response form;
6. I acknowledge that I may sign only one elector response form, regardless of the number of properties that I own in the Service Area;
7. I acknowledge that if there is more than one individual who is the registered owner of the property, only one of the individual owners may sign this elector response form in relation to the property, provided the non-resident property elector has the written consent of the number of individuals who, together with the person signing this elector response form, constitute a majority of the registered owners of the property (**written consent must be attached, if applicable; this form is available at: [www.slrd.bc.ca/PembertonDistrictArtsCultureEconomicDevelopment](http://www.slrd.bc.ca/PembertonDistrictArtsCultureEconomicDevelopment)**);
8. I acknowledge that the only persons who are registered owners of the real property are individuals who do not hold the property in trust for a corporation or another trust;
9. I am not disqualified from voting under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment or otherwise disqualified by law from voting.
