
**SQUAMISH-LILLOOET REGIONAL DISTRICT
BYLAW NO. 1644-2019**

A bylaw of the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District, in the Province of British Columbia, to establish an Economic Development Service for the Village of Pemberton and portion of Electoral Area "C"

WHEREAS:

- A. A regional district may, by bylaw, establish and operate a service under the provisions of Part 9 and Part 10 of the *Local Government Act*;
- B. The Regional Board considers it desirable to provide for the service of funding economic development functions for the Village of Pemberton and portion of Electoral Area "C";
- C. The approval of the Inspector of Municipalities has been obtained under section 342 of the *Local Government Act*;
- D. The Regional Board of the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District has received participating area approval of this service establishment bylaw under section 342 of the *Local Government Act* by approval of the electors in accordance with section 345 of the *Local Government Act* [approval by alternative approval process].

NOW THEREFORE, the Regional Board of the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Citation

- 1. This bylaw may be cited as "Squamish-Lillooet Regional District Pemberton and District Economic Development Service Establishing Bylaw No. 1644-2019".

Service Being Established

- 2. The Regional Board of the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District (the "Regional Board") hereby establishes a service for the purpose of providing support for projects, activities, organizations and groups that improve the local economic condition of the Service Area, including but not limited to work in important sectors such as tourism, agriculture, natural resource development and the retention and attraction of businesses and residents within the Village of Pemberton and portion of Electoral Area "C" (the "Service").
- 3. The Regional Board may enter into contracts with external parties to deliver the Service within the Service Area.

Service Area Boundaries

- 4. The boundaries of the Service Area shall be the boundaries as shown in Schedule "A" (the "Service Area"), attached to and forming part of this bylaw.

Participating Area

- 5. The participants in the Service established under Section 2 of this bylaw are the Village of Pemberton and Electoral Area "C".

Cost Recovery

- 6. As provided for in section 378 of the *Local Government Act*, the annual cost of providing the Service shall be recovered by:
 - (a) property value taxes imposed in accordance with Division 3 of Part 11 of the *Local Government Act*;
 - (b) parcel taxes imposed in accordance with Division 3 of Part 11 of the *Local Government Act*;
 - (c) fees and charges imposed under section 397 of the *Local Government Act*;
 - (d) revenues raised by other means authorized under the *Local Government Act* or another Act;
 - (e) revenues received by way of agreement, enterprise, gift, grant or otherwise.

Requisition Limits

- 7. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually for the Service shall be the greater of:
 - (a) \$50,000 or
 - (b) an amount equal to the amount that could be raised by a property value tax rate of \$0.0317/\$1,000 applied to the net taxable value of land and improvements.

Severability

- 8. If any provision of this bylaw is found invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the offending portion shall be severed. Such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this bylaw.

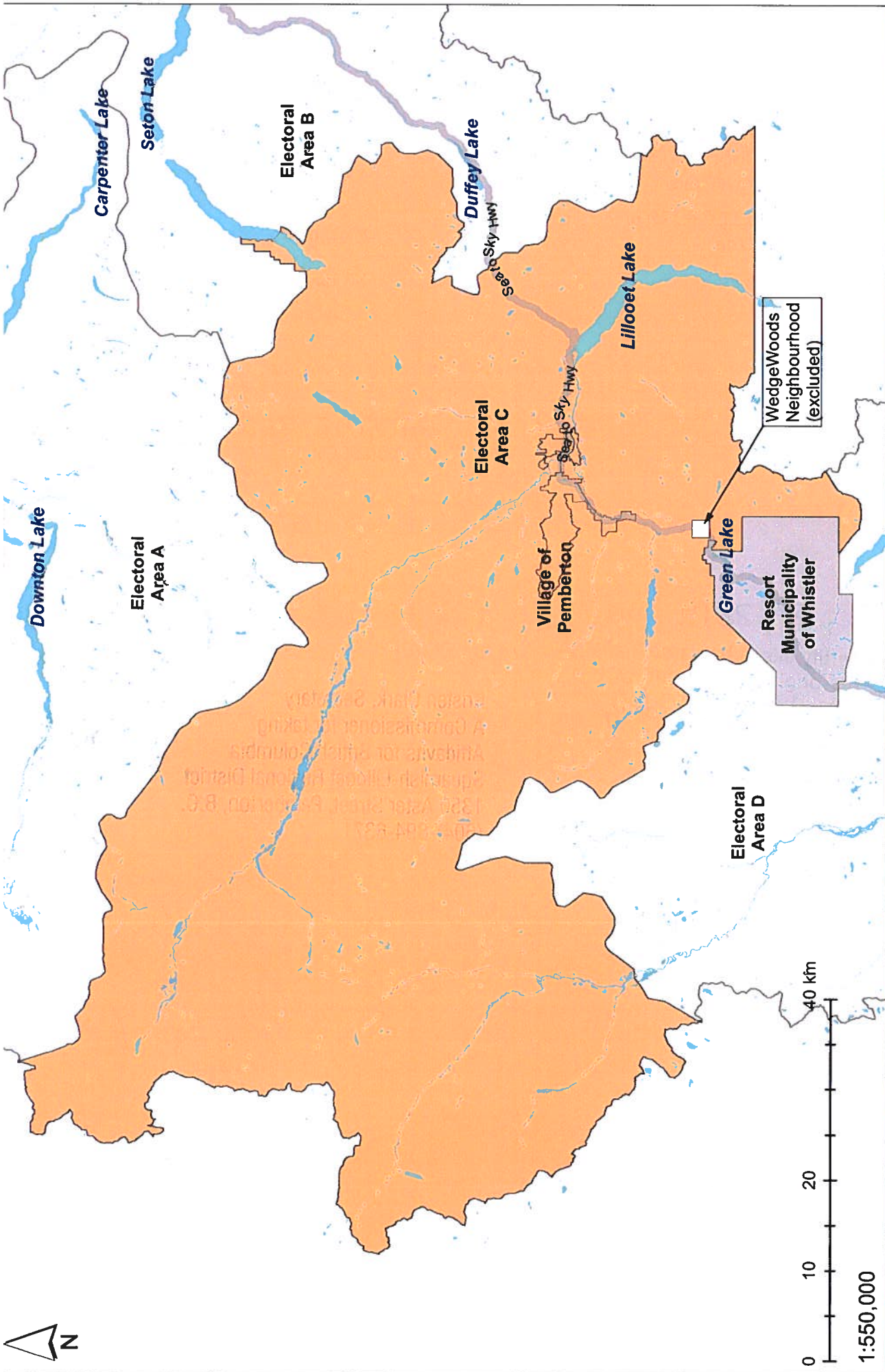
