The SLRD is a BC Regional District consisting of 4 member municipalities (Squamish, Whistler, Pemberton, Lillooet) and 4 electoral areas. Services include land use planning, solid waste management, building inspection, fire protection, emergency preparedness, 911 services, recreation, water and sewer utilities, regional transit, trails and open spaces as well as financial support for various community services. The region contains some of the most spectacular forests, waterways, and mountains in the province and affords an endless range of opportunities for outdoor adventure, making it an exceptional place to live, work and play.

The SLRD is seeking an experienced, organized and collaborative individual to fill the full-time position of **Maintenance and Utilities Technician**. This position is responsible for the operation, maintenance, repair and upkeep of SLRD facilities, utilities and infrastructure in Electoral Areas A & B (general information on SLRD Electoral Areas can be found at https://www.slrd.bc.ca/about-us/slrd-electoral-areas).

Qualified candidates possess a minimum of 3 years of related experience in addition to a high school diploma with post-secondary or industry training/certification in a related field. The ideal candidate is an effective communicator who is knowledgeable in building/facility/utility operational, maintenance and repair requirements, and who is able to build and maintain effective working relationships with a variety of groups including SLRD staff, contractors, the public, elected officials and other external partners. Due to the primary location of work, preference may be given to candidates residing in SLRD Electoral Area A.
