Bylaw No. 1604-2018

A bylaw to amend the Gun Lake Fire Protection Contribution Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 559, 1994

WHEREAS the Gun Lake Fire Protection Contribution Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 559, 1994 established a service for providing a financial contribution for fire protection to the community of Gun Lake;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District wishes to increase the maximum annual requisition limit;

AND WHEREAS the approval of the Inspector of Municipalities has been received under section 342 of the *Local Government Act*;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District has received participating area approval under section 342 of the *Local Government Act* by approval of the electors in accordance with section 345 of the *Local Government Act* [approval by alternative approval process];

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be cited as “Gun Lake Fire Protection Contribution Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 559, 1994, Amendment Bylaw No. 1604-2018”.
- 2. Section 5 of Gun Lake Fire Protection Contribution Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 559, 1994, is deleted and replaced with the following:
 - “5. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually for this service shall be the greater of \$21,750 or 0.20716/\$1,000 of the net taxable value of land and improvements.”
- 3. If any provision of this bylaw is found invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the offending portion shall be severed. Such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this bylaw.
