Unacceptable Wastes

- * Automobile hulks and engines
- * Rubber tires: with or without rims, 25" rim diameter and over
- * Radioactive wastes, hazardous wastes, reactive wastes, or wastes with toxic residue
- * Asbestos waste, dry slurry, and cement
- * Biomedical waste
- * Asphalt: includes road asphalt and hydrocarbon impacted soil
- * Animal wastes and carcasses
- * Oils, paints, glues, and solvents except for residential products covered under an approved stewardship program
- * E-waste
- * Contaminated soil
- * Gypsum board (drywall)
- * Mattresses
- * Yard waste: includes grass clippings, leaves, and prunings
- * Commercial waste
