CHECKLIST

- If waste contains friable asbestos fibres or asbestos dust greater than 1%, either at the time of manufacture or as determined using a method specified in Section 40(1) of the provincial Hazardous Waste Regulation, then an MOE Transport Manifest is required. This includes asbestos cement. Asbestos cement means shingles, tiles, siding, board or pipe containing asbestos material tightly bound within a solid matrix not easily crumbled by hand, but which is easily crumbled and made friable by equipment during landfill disposal.
- Forward a completed UES Lillooet Landfill Asbestos Disposal Form to the SLRD. Written approval by the SLRD must be obtained prior to disposal at the Lillooet Landfill.
- Appropriate MOE Transport Manifests must be completed and forwarded to the SLRD or given to the landfill attendant at the time of disposal.
- Asbestos can only be transported by a licensed Hazardous Waste Transport Company.
