PITCH IN WEEK: AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS

Stay Safe

Before...

- **Visit your site**, assess it for possible hazards. Youth are not encouraged to clean along roadsides or highways or around parked cars. For shoreline cleanups, schedule your clean-up when the water will be at a safe level.
- **What equipment do you need?** Safety vests? Gloves? Rakes, shovels? (Utilities and Environmental Services have bags available for pick-up)
- **How many supervisors will you need**, if working with a youth group or young children?
- **What will you do with the garbage you collect?** What can you recycle? There are tipping fee waiver vouchers available to organised events for pick-up at the SLRD Utilities and Environmental Services office.

During...

- **Closely supervise** the project and the participants. Do not allow youth to go near or in bush or wilderness areas alone!
- Do not allow participants to pick up any dangerous items, including broken glass, discarded needles, etc. Please phone Utilities and Environmental Services and let them know where these items are. **604 894-6371**
- **NEVER** attempt to clean up the remnants of a squatter's camp – call Utilities and Environmental Services to assist.
- Remind all participants to be very careful around parked cars, driveways and along roads and shorelines.
- Do not allow participants to carry heavy or bulky items.
- Arrange to properly dispose of all non-recyclable litter – one landfill waiver will be given to each registered group to attend the landfill with this litter.
- Wash hands thoroughly at the conclusion of the project.

- Try to separate recyclables and garbage to assist our depots
