Introduction to recycling



Curbside Collection

In Britannia Beach and Furry Creek, recycling (paper and packaging) and organics are collected curbside.

Recycling, organics and landfill waste totes may only be placed at the curb between 6 am - 7 pm on collection day. Totes must be locked and stored in a Wildlife Resistant Enclosure until scheduled pick up.

Leave 1 meter between totes when at the curb.



What is Accepted

The Recycle BC curbside collection program accepts plastic, metal and carton containers as well as paper products.

*Do not bag items, leave them loose.

Community Glass Depot

Britannia Beach and Furry Creek have community glass bottles and jars drop-off locations.

Ask a neighbour for the location or email utilities@slrd.bc.ca.

Depot Only Items

Recycle BC accepts other materials for recycling at depot locations:

- Foam packaging
- Flexible plastics (plastic bags, overwrap, etc)
- Glass bottles and jars

What is Contamination?

Items that are not accepted by the program or only accepted at depots are considered contamination when placed in the curbside tote. Accepted items that are not rinsed are also considered contamination.

Contamination reduces the recyclability of the community's recycling.
