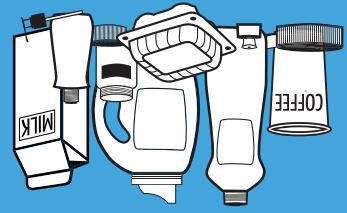

- Plastic containers
  - Cartons
  - Hot & cold beverage cups
- Empty & rinsed, labels ok

# Plastic Containers & Paper Cartons



- Not accepted:**
- Paper towel, napkins, tissues
  - Non paper gift wrap
  - Anything with padding, wax coatings or foil linings
  - Books

- Accepted:**
- Clean, dry & flattened
  - Printed paper
  - Magazines
  - Paper bags
  - Paper packaging for dry items (cereal, etc.)

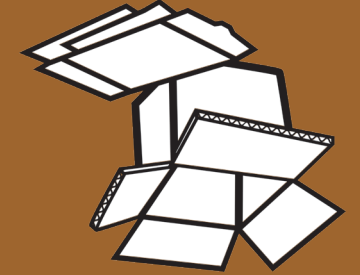


# Paper



- Not accepted:**
- Boxes with wax coatings
  - Heavily food soiled cardboard

- Accepted:**
- Clean, dry & flattened boxes, flattened
  - Corrugated cardboard



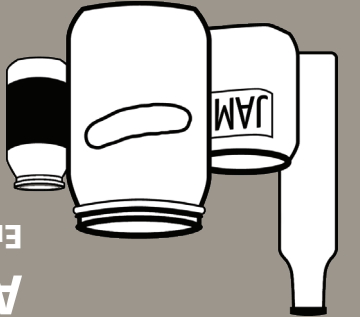
# Cardboard



- Not accepted:**
- Non-packaging glass like drinking glass, dishes, cookware, windows & ceramics
  - Lids - please remove and recycle with mixed containers

- Accepted:**
- Clear and coloured non beverage glass bottles and jars

# Wildlife

Access to waste (garbage, recycling and organics) is a leading cause of wildlife conflicts. Keep wildlife wild and your community safe:

- ✓ Store waste indoors or in bear-resistant containers. Truck canopies are not bear-resistant.
- ✓ Ensure recyclables are clean & stored indoors.
- ✓ Freeze smelly items in newspaper & rinse organic collection bins.

Leaving attractants accessible to wildlife is against SLRD bylaws & the BC Wildlife Act.

# FIRE FUEL MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

From Easter weekend to Thanksgiving weekend (weather permitting).

## Accepted:

Clean organic wood debris (pruned branches, shrubs, stumps, fallen trees).

## Not Accepted:

Lawn trimmings, lumber, furniture, construction material.

# Zero in on Waste

1. Cut out each recycling category panel.
2. Place them on the appropriate recycling collection bin so your household knows what goes where.

# Reuse it, repurpose it

Divert waste from landfills by giving your used furniture, clothing, electronics, sports equipment or small appliances a new life!

# Garbage to Landfill



Small bag (< 40 L or 9 kg)  
Large bag (> 40 L or 9 kg)  
Per truckload for larger loads

**Reduce costs by reducing waste.**

## Not accepted:

- Recyclables
- Commercial recycling
- Refuse loads greater than a pick-up truck with sideboards: Take to Lillooet Landfill
- Hazardous waste (ask attendant)
- Animal carcasses

## TIPPING FEES

Waste management fees are collected by taxes & tipping fees. Tipping fees ensure that those who generate the waste help to cover the disposal cost.

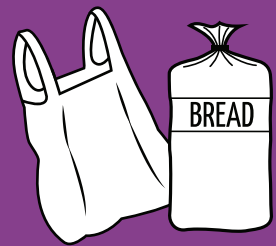

# Plastic Bags & Overwrap

## Accepted:

- Bags for groceries, dry cleaning, bread, newspaper, etc.
- Produce & bulk food bags
- Outer bags for paper towels, diapers, popcans, etc.
- Overwrap on furniture



## Not accepted:

- Crinkly cellophane or stretch wrap
- Zipper lock bags
- Biodegradable or compostable bags
- Shipping envelopes or bubble wrap
- Multilayer bags (chips, coffee, pet food etc.)

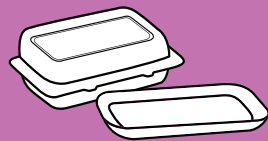
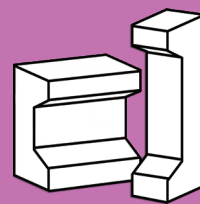


# Foam Packaging White & Coloured

## Accepted:

Rinse & remove other materials, keep colours separate.

- Foam meat & produce trays
- Foam egg cartons
- Foam clamshells, cups & bowls for take-out food
- Foam cushion packaging to protect electronics, small appliances, etc.



## Not accepted:

- Foam packing chips, peanuts or noodles
- Liquid absorbing pads or stretch wrap
- Blue or pink foam board insulation

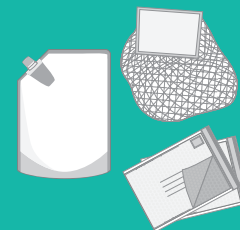
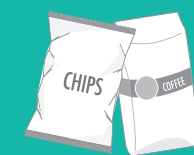


# Other Flexible Plastic Packaging

## Accepted:

Must be clean & dry

- Crinkly wrappers & bags
- Flexible packaging with plastic seal
- Stand-up & zipper lock pouches
- Woven & net plastic bags
- Non-food protective packaging



## Not accepted:

- Plastic squeeze tubes (e.g. tooth paste)
- Plastic-lined paper or paper-lined plastic
- Biodegradable or compostable plastic
- PVC or Vinyl
- Plastic strapping
- 6-pack rings



# Metal Containers

## Accepted:

Empty & rinsed, labels ok

- Aluminium & steel cans and lids used for food
- Foil wrap, take-out containers & food trays
- Empty aerosol containers



Return deposit beverage containers for refunds.

## Not accepted:

- Spray paint cans
- Aerosol cans with contents remaining
- Pots, pans, baking trays & coat hangers
- Propane cylinders
- Foil-lined cardboard
