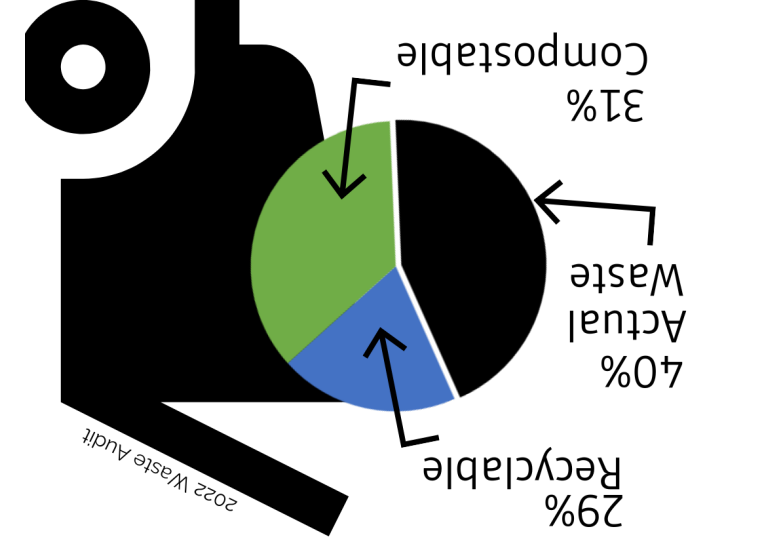

- Not accepted:**
- Boxes with wax coatings
 - Heavily food soiled cardboard

Cardboard

Accepted:

- Clean, dry & flattened boxes, flattened corrugated cardboard

Not accepted:

- Heavily food soiled cardboard
- Non paper gift wrap
- Wax coatings
- Plastic or foil linings
- Books

RECYCLE BC

- Not accepted:**
- Paper towel, napkins, tissues
 - Heavily food soiled cardboard
 - Non paper gift wrap
 - Wax coatings
 - Plastic or foil linings
 - Books

Printed Paper

Accepted:

- Empty & Flattened

Not accepted:

- Paper party decorations
- Newspaper & flyers
- Boxboard boxes & packaging
- Magazines & catalogues
- Household paper & envelopes
- Moulded cardboard packaging

RECYCLE BC

- Not accepted:**
- Stand-up pouches or other flexible plastic
 - Biodegradable or compostable packaging

Plastic Containers & Cartons

Accepted: Empty & Rinsed

- Plastic jars & lids
- Plastic bottles, caps & pumps
- Plastic trays & clamshells
- Spray bottles
- Plastic trays & tops
- Non-durable plastic food containers
- Paper cans
- Spiral wound
- Chips

Wildlife

Access to waste (garbage, recycling and organics) is a leading cause of wildlife conflicts. Keep wildlife wild and your community safe:

- ✓ Store waste indoors or in bear-resistant containers. Truck canopies are not bear-resistant.
- ✓ Ensure recyclables are clean & stored indoors.
- ✓ Freeze smelly items in newspaper & rinse organic collection bins.

Leaving attractants accessible to wildlife is against SLRD bylaws & the BC Wildlife Act.

FIRE FUEL MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

From Easter weekend to Thanksgiving weekend (weather permitting).

Accepted:

Clean organic wood debris (pruned branches, shrubs, stumps, fallen trees).

Not Accepted:

Lawn trimmings, lumber, furniture, construction material.

Zero in on Waste

1. Cut out each recycling category panel.
2. Place them on the appropriate recycling collection bin so your household knows what goes where.

Tip: The coloured dots help you pick the right bin!

Garbage to Landfill



Small bag (< 77 L or 18 kg)
Large bag (> 77 L or 18 kg)
Per truckload for larger loads

Reduce costs by reducing waste.

Loads greater than a pickup truck with side-boards/2m³: Take to the Lillooet Landfill & Recycling Centre.

Not accepted in garbage:

- Hazardous waste
- Animal carcasses
- Recyclables
- Pre-1990 drywall*

* Accepted at the Lillooet Landfill with pre-approval

TIPPING FEES

Waste management fees are collected by taxes & tipping fees. Tipping fees ensure that those who generate the waste help to cover the disposal cost.

Effective January 1, 2023

Good news! More items are now accepted for recycling.

Your single-use and packaging-like products can now be recycled from home and the depot through Recycle BC's updated program.

✓ Paper

- Paper party decorations
- Paper gift bags
- Paper lunch bags
- Moving and storage boxes
- Paper gift boxes



✓ Flexible Plastics (Depot only)

- Sandwich and freezer bags
- Plastic reusable shopping bags
- Squishy cushion packaging
- Plastic wrap
- Plastic drop sheets or covering
- Plastic recycling bags



✓ Containers

- Aluminum foil trays and pie plates
- Plastic food storage containers
- Plastic and paper cups, plates, and bowls
- Disposable hangers
- Plastic plant pots
- Metal storage containers (e.g. for candy, etc.)
- Plastic utensils and straws



Reuse what you can. Recycle what you can't.

New Items



Flexible Plastics

Accepted: Empty & Rinsed



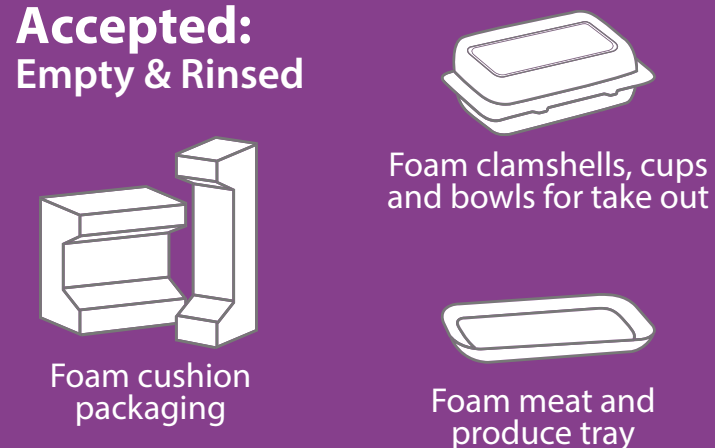
Not accepted:

- Plastic-lined paper or paper-lined plastic ●
- Biodegradable or compostable plastic ●
- Plastic squeeze tubes (e.g. tooth paste) ●
- Plastic strapping ●
- PVC or Vinyl ●



Foam Packaging Separate White & Coloured

Accepted: Empty & Rinsed



Not accepted:

- Foam packing chips, peanuts or noodles ●
- Liquid absorbing pads or stretch wrap ●
- Blue or pink foam board insulation ●



Metal Containers

Accepted:

Empty & rinsed, labels ok

- Aluminium & steel cans and lids used for food
- Foil wrap, take-out containers & food trays
- Empty aerosol cans
- Thin metal tins



Return deposit beverage containers for refunds.

Not accepted:

- Spray paint cans (LRC)
- Aerosol cans with contents remaining
- Pots, pans, baking trays & coat hangers ●
- Propane cylinders (LRC)
- Foil-lined carboard ●
