

***Building – Policy for Completion of Building Permits – expired permit and construction is not completed.***

**Policy:**

A new building permit will be required for building permits that have expired and more than a Final Inspection is outstanding and construction has not been completed beyond the next required inspection.

**Procedure:**

The SLRD acknowledges that there are new Building Codes that are adopted from time to time. On January 28, 2008, the Regional Board moved that a policy be implemented; that a new building permit will be required when the building permit expires and more than a Final Inspection is outstanding and construction has not been completed beyond the next required inspection.

1. Advise owners that a new building permit is required if their building permit has expired and they wish to proceed with the construction.
