

Evacuation Alert for Lillooet Lake Estates, Heather Jean Properties, and all other identified properties in – SLRD Electoral Area C

The **Squamish-Lillooet Regional District** has been advised by the Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development (MFLNRORD) that a wildfire burning above Lillooet Lake and the In-SHUCK-ch Forest Service Road, combined with forecast precipitation that may exceed 5mm per hour, has created conditions that present an increased risk of a debris flow down the McCulloch Creek drainage.

Only some properties are assessed as being at direct risk from the debris flow (see map). However, due to the potential for the In-SHUCK-ch Forest Service Road to be damaged, thus preventing evacuation towards Highway 99 and Pemberton, all properties in this area have been placed under this Evacuation Alert.

Accordingly, the SLRD has issued an Evacuation Alert for:

- Lillooet Lake Estates,
- Heather Jean Properties, and
- All other properties as outlined on the **attached map**.

This Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Prepare now to leave quickly. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however, conditions can change quickly. MFLNRORD advises that if heavy rain (greater than 5 mm/hour) is occurring, either evacuate immediately or remain indoors. **Do not go near the creek or investigate loud sounds.** If thunder or lightning is observed, evacuate immediately or remain indoors. The safest place to remain indoors is an upstairs floor, or on the downhill side of the house.

Additional evacuation route details will be provided if an evacuation becomes necessary.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO WHEN AN ALERT IS IN EFFECT

- Locate all family members or co-workers and designate a meeting location outside the evacuation area, should an evacuation be called while separated.
- Gather essential items such as medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (i.e. insurance), immediate care needs for dependents and, if you choose, keepsakes (photographs, etc.). Have these items readily available for quick departure.
- Prepare to move any disabled persons and/or children.
- Move pets and livestock to a safe area.
- Arrange to transport your household members or co-workers in the event of an evacuation order. If you need transportation assistance from the area please call the SLRD EOC at **(604) 698-6442 or 604 356 3082**
