### RESIDENT ELECTORS:

- 18 years of age or older on January 26, 2019; and
- a Canadian citizen; and
- a resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately before the voting day; and
- a resident of the Bralorne Sewer Service Area for at least 30 days immediately before the voting day; and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act*, *School Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election/assent vote or otherwise disqualified by law.

### NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTORS:

- 18 years of age or older on January 26, 2019; and
- a Canadian citizen; and
- a resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately before the voting day; and
- a registered owner of real property in the Bralorne Sewer Service Area for at least 30 days immediately before the voting day; and
- not entitled to register as a resident elector; and
- the only persons who are registered owners of the real property, either as joint tenants or tenants in common, are individuals who are not holding the property in trust for a corporation or another trust; and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act*, *School Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election/assent vote or otherwise disqualified by law; and
- if there is more than one registered owner of the property, only one of those individuals may, with the written consent of the majority of the owners, register as a non-resident property elector.
